Austin Andrews is an award-winning director, editor and motion designer with experience on a variety of film, TV and documentary projects. Credits as director include the **feature film** *Oblivion*, **nationwide television campaigns** for Globalstar Australia, LG and Samsung, and **several acclaimed short dramas**. His film *How My Next Door Neighbour Discovered Life On Mars* screened to festival audiences of two million on every continent and won over fifteen awards, while the candy-coloured comedy *Kite Circuit* premiered at the prestigious Tribeca Film Festival. His newest film, the much-anticipated *Frog* starring Allison Mack of TV's *Smallville*, is set for festival release in 2010.

A three time **Telly Award-winning editor**, Austin has edited over thirty hours of series and commercial television for networks including NBC, Global, Bravo! and CNN, including the internationally syndicated programs *A&E Biography* and *Inside Entertainment*. His acclaimed photojournalism work spans five continents and has appeared in magazines including *Foreign Policy* and *Intersection*, and in the online editions of *National Geographic* and *TIME*.
