Credits as director include the **feature film** *Oblivion*, **nationwide television campaigns** for LG and Samsung, and **several acclaimed short films**. His past three films screened to combined audiences of over two million on every continent at festivals including Tribeca, IFF Rome and the Vancouver International Film Festival, winning more than fifteen awards.

A three time **Telly Award-winning editor**, Austin has edited over thirty hours of series and commercial television, including episodes of the Emmy Award-winning *A&E Biography*. He most recently edited the theatrical feature film *Replicas* starring Selma Blair.

Austin's **acclaimed photojournalism** includes spot news and feature reportage on five continents. Publications his work has appeared in include *Macleans*, *Foreign Policy*, and the online editions of *National Geographic* and *TIME*.
